



TAD Graduate Student Travel Scholarships – September 2023

The Center for AI and Data Science at Tel Aviv University (TAD) is announcing a new program for Student Travel Scholarships for the year 2023/2024. This program is funded with the support of Dr. Monique Barel, in the memory of Sylvain Barel.

Scholarships are offered for **Graduate students to partially cover active participation (poster or lecture) in international conferences or workshops in the field of Artificial Intelligence (AI)**. Students are eligible to apply for a travel scholarship in the amount of up to \$750.

Papers submitted to this call can be in any field but are required to have a substantial AI/DS component. This call is primarily targeted to papers accepted to top competitive conferences. Papers accepted for oral presentation at other conferences will also be considered, on an availability basis.

Interested students working in the field of AI are invited to submit their applications by email to shiristemp@tauex.tau.ac.il.

Applications should include in one pdf file:

1. Short CV (up to 2 pages).
2. A letter of recommendation by the advisor of the applicant (max. 1 page).
3. Name of Conference/Workshop, date and location.
4. Notice of acceptance to the conference or workshop.
5. Research abstract of the poster or lecture to be presented (including title and authors).
In the case of a workshop, please provide a letter of invitation from the host stating the nature of the workshop.
6. a) The total cost of the travel (flight, registration, accommodation).
b) The requested amount from TAD for the travel.
c) Funding by other sources (including the advisor support and Science Relations Fund).

*Applications not conforming to the requested format will not be considered.

The scholarships are not retroactive. Applications that are incomplete will not be considered. The scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis and can be awarded only once for each applicant.

** In the case the application is approved by TAD, the applicants are required to add to their poster/ presentation the following acknowledgment:
